Chapter 1

There are things that other cultures teach and have and ways they they do things that are actually better than the way that we do them!

SHOCK of all SHOCKS!!! How dare we say such a thing???

We can say it because it is true!

Most of the things that we accept as fact and true and above question are things that have been passed on to us. We have been brainwashed and indoctrinated into believing certain things and we are continually reinforced to hold on to those beliefs and considerations.

But even so, would it not be sinful for two or more women to consider themselves married to the same man?

The straight answer is NO!!!

Yet if you ask traditionally trained pastors or so called spiritual leaders about this, they will get out their well indoctrinated eye glasses and twist some scriptures from the Bible to try to say that it is wrong and sinful.

He makes the rules, we don't!

Man often changes the rules to his own liking, but that does not negate what God has established.

Chapter 3

HISTORY

As far back as the time before the flood, there were men with more than one wife. Lameck is recorded as having two wives.

Oh, but the religious leaders will say, "He was a murderer. See what happens when you have two wives!"

That is ludicrous!!!

The Bible says that Cain was a tiller of the soil. He was the first murderer! We could use the same logic to say, "See what happens when you are a farmer? You become a murderer!"

That is absolutely ridiculous reasoning!!!

After Noah's time, Terah had two wives. There is no record of God ever condemning him for having two wives.

Abraham had two wives, Sarah and Hagar. God never condemned Abraham for having two wives.

"Oh wait a minute," The religious leaders will say, "There was jealousy between Hagar and Sarah and eventually God told Abraham to send Hagar away."

That did not mean that God is always against a man having two or more wives.!

Jealousy and envy are a part of the fleshy nature, the adamic fallen nature. It is in the carnal nature of mankind! One can over come it.

Sometimes two siblings of the same parents are jealous of each other. Does that mean that parents should have only one child to avoid jealousy?

That would be utterly stupid!!!

After Sarah died, Abraham married Keturah and he had other concubines (Wives with no inheritance rights).

God never condemned Abraham for having at least three more wives!

Esau had three wives. His parents were not upset with the number of wives but only that the wives were Hitittes.

Jacob had four wives. God never condemned him for that! The sons from those four wives became the fathers of what was to become the twelve tribes of Israel.

Religious leaders don't like this because they have been thoroughly brainwashed into believing that having more than one wife is evil.

Yet anyone can read in the record in the bible. It is the for all to see.

Caleb had two wives.

Moses had three wives.

Gideon had many wives.

David had at least twenty one wives.

God never condemned anyone of these men for having more than one wife!!!

There are many more in the old testament that had many wives and God did not condemn them either!

Solomon is the one exception. He had 1000 wives. Maybe that was too many. However, the main rebuke by God has to do with his marrying wives from other nations more so than the number.

Did you know that Bible even gives rules on having more than one wife?(See Exodus 21:10)

In some cases it was a man's duty to have more than one wife!

I'll bet that you have never heard a sermon on that!!!

Have you? (See Deuteronomy 25:5-10)

Now at this point a religious person will be screaming, "Wait!!!, Wait! All that stuff is in the old testament. God winked at their ignorance!"

Now the religious zealot is showing his own ignorance. That which the bible says that God winked is at as not a man having more than one wife but about the gentiles serving idols! See Acts 17: 22-30.

Now our well indoctrinated religious zealot is ready scream, "God changed things in the New Testament!" he gasps and then goes on to say, "We are under the New Testament and not the Old Testament. Thing have changed!"

Well, he is partly right,
Let's look at that in the next chapter.

Chapter 4

JESUS AND THE EARLY CHURCH

The old Testament laws could be divided into three parts. There were the moral laws which included but are not limited to such things as the Ten Commandments.

Then there was the civil laws that spelled out punishments for disobeying the law and rewards for obedience. (these are now handled by the civil government of a given

nation or state or city within their particular jurisdiction)

Then, Thirdly, there were the ceremonial or shadow laws.

These the scripture says were nailed to the cross with Jesus. These are no longer required because Jesus fulfilled them.

(See Colossians 2:13-23)

Now in which category would the rule requiring a brother to marry a dead brother's wife fall? (See Deuteronomy 25:5-10)

Is it Moral law, perhaps?

We see in three of the four gospels there are certain ones asking Jesus about this as it pertains to which one of seven brothers would have her as a wife in heaven. Jesus never said that we don't do this anymore.

He certainly could have said that if He wanted to change things, but he didn't!

If any of the seven brothers who subsequently married the widow was already married when he married her, he would have been a polygamist!

"Hold on!" the brainwashed religious zealot will now cry out, "Jesus said, if a man marries another, he commits adultery against the first wife!"

NO!!! That is not what the scripture says!!! Jesus said, "If a man DIVORCES his wife, except for the cause of fornication, and marries another, he causes her to commit adultery."

To really understand this we need to consider that the Matthew 5 passage and the Matthew 19 passage and the Mark 10 passage are all saying the same thing.

" But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery..." Matthew 5:32

"And he saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife and marry another committeth adultery against her." Mark 10:11

"And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another committeth adultery..." Matthew 19:9

The first thing that we should notice is that the subject of all three passages is

DIVORCE!

Jesus is explaining that it is WRONG TO DIVORCE A WIFE, IN ORDER TO MARRY ANOTHER.

Adultery comes from the Hebrew word "Naaph" it means a woman that breaks wedlock. (See String's Exhaustive Bible Concordance)

If a man unfairly, unjustly divorces his wife, he commits adultery AGAINST HER by placing her in a position to have to marry another man while he is still alive!

That is why one passage says plainly, "Causes her to commit adultery". Causing her to commit adultery is the act of committing adultery against her.

It is NOT adultery when a man has sexual relations with any of his legitimate wives!

If a man has sex with a woman who is not his wife who is not married, then that is fornication. (Sex outside marriage). It is wrong, it is sin. However, it is not adultery! For adultery to occur a married woman must be involved. If he has sex with another man's wife, THAT IS adultery!

Jesus is against divorce! He is not against a man having more than one wife.

If he was against a man having more than one wife, he would have never depicted himself as the Bridegroom who comes and marries FIVE wise virgins. (see Matthew 25:1-10)

I hope that this is shaking up those that have been indoctrinated into the false "Monogamy is the only right way" doctrine!

Now they bring another argument in to prop up their "Monogamy Only" sacred cow.

"the husband of one wife".

Chapter 5

Husband of One Wife

Now the religious zealots for "Monogamy Only" fall back to the ultimate stopper. First Timothy 3:2, 1st Timothy 3:12, and Titus 1:6

"This a true saying, if a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work.

A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, ..." 1st Timothy 3;1,2

Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife ruling their children and their own houses well." 1st timothy 3:12

" For this cause left I thee in Crete, that thou shouldest set in order the things wanting and ordain elders in every city, as I appointed thee.

If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly."

Titus 1:5,6

These are the only scriptures that SEEM to say that some men (Bishops, elders and deacons) are limited to one wife!

I say SEEM to say because that is NOT really what Paul, the apostle, was saying. But EVEN IF, he meant to say what it APPEARS to say on the surface, this still would only be a restriction on only bishops, elders and deacons. That would mean that any man who did not desire to be a bishop, elder or deacon could have more than one wife.

However, it doesn't really even restrict them! If you research the Greek language in which it was originally written, the word one is the word "mia". that word in other places in the scripture is translated "a" "A certain" or "first"

I have checked with a student of the Biblical Greek used in the bible. This gentleman had studied the language for three years at one of the nations most prestigious Bible colleges.

He agrees that that the meaning should be the article "a"

It should therefore say, "The husband of a wife.." with the meaning that it should be a married man.

This is borne out in the context of the passage, which says that "if a man knows not how to rule his own house, how should he take care of the church of God."

An unmarried man with no wife and therefore no children would have no household to rule. Consequently, he would have no natural experience and thus disqualifying him.

BEWARE!!! Many translations are adding the word "ONLY" in front of one or they are saying, "BUT ONE". these other words are not in the original.

I repeat! those other words are NOT in the original manuscripts. They were added by modern translators as they allowed their own biases and traditions seep through into their translation.

So those that think that Paul, the apostle, made a change from the old testament policy of polygamy being an acceptable form of marriage to one in the New Testament that says it is no longer acceptable, ARE WRONG!!!

Now ladies, that means that you can marry who ever you wish , "only in the Lord!"

Chapter 6

ONLY IN THE LORD

Paul the apostle said in 1st Corinthians 7:39 that if a woman's husband dies, she is at liberty to marry whom she will: only in the Lord.

Notice that it did NOT say she could marry whom she will only in the Lord , IF he is single!

That means that you, my dear sisters can marry a married man IF he is a Christian!!!

In 1st Timothy 5:11-14 this same Paul, the apostle, says he desires younger widows to marry.

Since most churches usually have more women than men and since women generally live longer than men, it becomes obvious that many of the younger widows would be marrying men who would already be married.

To the Israelite, of which Paul was one, this is no big thing, since it was common amongst the Israelites to have more than one wife.

Remember that the church started off being all Jewish and then we find that the gentiles are grafted in.

(See Romans 11:17-20)

Paul, the apostle, also points out that the Jews have an advantage because to them were given the oracles of God!
(See Romans 3:1,2)

Yes, there were certain of the Jewish shadow laws that Paul verbally spoke against the gentile believers being required to observe, such as circumcision. However, he never fought against a man having more than one wife!

Chapter 7

THE ROMANIZATION OF THE CHURCH

So the church started off Jewish and followed Jewish customs. The Gentiles who were under domination of the Roman empire which was the world power at that time, began to come into the church. Over time, more and more Roman traditions were added to the practices of believers.

The Roman custom was "monogamy". The typical Roman only had one wife, although some had secret mistresses on the side. Others kept boys with which they committed homosexual acts.

When Constantine claimed to see a vision of the cross and went forth conquering with that sign, he legalized Christianity. The now legalized Christian Church gradually adopted more and more Roman customs and traditions.

By the fifth Century Pope Innocence began to push for the priests to be monogamous and then eventually to be celibate. Apparently the Roman Church wanted all the priests possessions to be inherited by the church rather than any children that a priest might have., This made the Roman Church grow richer! Eventually the one man one wife rule was extended to the common man.

At the council of Trent held between 1532 and 1565 there were a number of edicts that went forth. One of those, was that if any man said that a man could have more than one wife he was to be accursed!

As protestants broke away from the ROMAN Catholic Church, they took with them many of the dogmas and traditions and customs of the Roman Church. Among those was the "one man one wife" rule.

In 1611 when the first King James Bible was printed, the men who had translated it to English had grown up in a religious environment that believed that it was sinful for a man to have more than one wife. Consequently when they translated the Timothy and Titus passages, they translated the Greek word "mia" as one rather than "first" or "a". Thus leaving the impression that Paul was saying that a man could only have one wife, rather than what he really meant, which was that it was best for an elder to be a married man.

Thus, generations following, not knowing what the Greek really said, dutifully followed the one wife rule. Assuming that the elders were to be examples to others, they demanded that if leaders could only have one wife then that was true for everyone else!

Although Martin Luther began a restoration of truth to the church, he did not complete it!

God is now calling forth prophetic men and women to continue to deliver the true church from the falsehoods sown into it by the spirit of ROME!

Jesus said, "If you continue in my word, ye shall know the truth and the truth will make you free."!!!

Chapter 8

INSTRUCTING THE BROTHERS

Now dear sisters, the next obstacle is to instruct the brothers. Since most of them in the Western Society and many in Eastern and even African countries have been indoctrinated into believing the "Monogamy Only" doctrine, you have your work cut out for you.

One of the ways that this can be accomplished is to give them access to books like this one and others such as "Journey Into A Truth", "Truth Or Tradition", and "Beyond Tradition and Into Truth". These three are all by the same author.

"The Truth Revealed" by Dr. David Gideon, is also a good one.

You should note that most people do not instantaneously make a turn around when they hear this truth. The indoctrination into the "Monogamy Only" belief system and the supposed ills of polygamy has been pounded in so long and hard that it takes most some time to change their thinking.

Sometimes a book or a message will merely serve to get them thinking and hopefully studying the word for themselves.

"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that need not be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth"
2nd Timothy 2;15

Religious leaders are the hardest to persuade!

Why?

Because they have the most to lose!

If they have preached "Monogamy" as the only right way, then they would lose face to admit that they were wrong! Most are not that humble.

Second, some of their congregations wouldn't like the message and would leave and brand the minister a heretic in the process.

We have found that it is the case that even many of those that know and believe

the truth of this message will refuse to teach it or to be associated with those that teach it, for fear of harming their ministries!

You see, ministry has become their god!

Still there will be some brothers who will hear the message.

Some will like it because in their minds it gives them the opportunity to have different sexual partners. Now admittedly that is a poor reason, but unfortunately that is where some brothers are.

Others will have enough money and enough of God's love that they will be willing to take another wife for her benefit and not just his own pleasure. These men are few, but there are some.

Ideally, as time goes on and as brethren grow in their love of God and His people, there will be many more that will be willing to take on the responsibility of another wife out of just plain obedience to God.

First, the brothers must be educated. Let's put materials in their hands that will do just that. Then let us also call in teachers who know and can teach this truth!

Chapter 9

FIRST WIVES

Sometimes even harder than convincing a brother that he can and perhaps should take a second wife, is convincing a first wife that she should share a husband! One thing is particularly true in the Western World. Girls have been brought up to compete with other girls for the best man and then when he is captured (married), to keep him and own him as there very own and never to be shared with him anyone else!

We are trained by our cultures what is acceptable and what is not. All elements of Western society teaches a woman that her husband is her's and her's alone. The parents say so. The media (television, movies and magazines) says so. The education system says so and the government says so. In addition the government backs that up in law!

An experiment was done at one college where they had several participants to agree in advance that when they saw a red spot on a TV screen to say that it was blue. After several people said the red spot was blue, the subject of the experiment who was not in on the deception, then also said that the red spot was blue! This was the case even though he was not color blind and could clearly see that it was red!

Why?

People hate to be different! They are influenced by peer pressure. The peer pressure for "monogamy only" is immense and intense in Western Society.

As Western societal values and traditions are imposed on the rest of the world, they too will feel the pressure to be "Monogamy only" when it comes to marriage.

Godly men and women who truly study their Bibles and insist on allegiance to God and His word more than allegiance to the world's idols, will seek to live in truth and walk in truth!

We must encourage first wives who say they are believers to grow in love to a point that they can suppress all tendencies to be jealous and develop a willingness to share a good man.

When I asked a first wife of a man that lived in Kenya why she was not jealous of the second wife and what she would say to American women, she said, "I would tell them they should stop being jealous and learn to love one another."

When we can get people to stop being jealous and to truly love each other, then

things can change for the better.

Then, sisters you will be able to share a man and a good husband can be yours!

Chapter 10

THE ROMANTic IDOL

The Greeks and the Romans worshipped goddesses and other false gods. Aphrodite in Greece and Venus in Rome is considered the goddess of love.(Lust would probably be more accurate)

In the first century a man named Ovid is said to be the one responsible for writing stories where the man worshipped the woman he loved. Apparently the people living at that time knew that his writing was facetious and not

serious. Later writers took his writing seriously and as the way love should be approached. Later stories like "Romeo and Juliet" and other such "Love" stories began to appear. Today, the way Western culture see it, this is the ideal.

The son of the love goddess was called Eros by the Greeks and cupid by the Romans.

Some believe that these are actually unclean spirits of lust that cause a man to be blinded in a sense and to yield to the woman in worship of her

This can be seen in the idealistic modern version of ROMANce. In that ideal, the man bows down on one knee as the woman either sits or stands before him. He then asks for her hand in marriage as he gives her a diamond ring which signifies his love for her and EXCLUSIVELY for her for the rest of their lives.

If he does not actually say these words then he will be required to say them at the wedding ceremony! "Keeping only to thee, so long as we both shall live"

The legal contract signed by them and the minister or judge in the USA backs up the fact that he must be "faithful" ONLY to her!!!

WHY???

Is it because "no man can serve two masters", and she is being appointed master over him?

Scripturally the man should be the head of the relationship. he should be the master. A servant can not serve two masters but a Master can have two or more servants!

A husband can have more than one helpmeet (wife).

A woman, on the other hand, can only have one master (Husband).

In the ROMANce idolatry, things have changed from the Biblical requirements to worldly ones that have been influenced by Satan!

In ROMANtic love both the men and the women are taught that a man can only have one woman. If a man says to a woman, "I love you", and I also love Sally and Karen and Susan", the woman from Western Tradition and culture will be confused!

"How can you say you love them if you say that you love me?" she might ask. It does not make sense to her, because she has been trained to think that his love for her must be exclusive!

However, a man is to have Agape love for his wife (or wives). Agape love is far above eros love. Agape is God's type of love. Just as God loves all of us, so a man can love all of his wives.

Agape love is not exclusive.

Eros love though being the lowest and most base of the three types of love has been elevated in the Western world and placed on a pedestal so to speak, to be worshipped!

Many people only stay married as long as they stay "in love"! (meaning eros love). When the eros love leaves then they leave.

"God would not want me to be unhappy!" they reason.

Divorce follows!

This is not the will of GOD!

In fact, it is the worship of what has become an idol! "ROMANtic Love"!

Chapter 11

IF YOU'LL BOW DOWN

Satan offered Jesus all the kingdoms of the world IF he would bow down and worship him.

Jesus wanted all the kingdoms and eventually he gets them. We know this because it is recorded in Revelations 11:15 "The kingdoms of this world are become the Kingdom of our God and His Christ."

Satan was offering a short cut! A supposedly easier way than through the cross. All he had to do was to bow down and worship Satan.

Jesus responded, "it is written; Thou shalt worship the Lord Thy God and Him only shalt thou serve."

In Roman or Romantic love, the man is tempted to bow down before the woman and worship her.

By vowing to love her EXCLUSIVELY, he is indirectly saying that she is the master. " No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one and love the other; or he will hold to the one and despise the other...."Matthew 6:24

Yet over and over again, the scripture says the man must be the head and the ruler over his wife.

Satan seeks to invert things. just as he desired to exalt himself above the station that God had for him, he and his unclean demonic spirits desire that the woman exalt herself over the man, destroying God's established order.

Let's consider some of the things with which romantic love is associated. a dark room with only dim candlelight is considered Romantic.

Why?

Is it because Satan is the god of darkness?

Drinking wine and other alcoholic beverages is considered romantic.

Why?

Is it because seduction is easier if the parties are drunk?

Does Satan seek to seduce us into yielding to sin as a sinful man often seeks to seduce a woman into fornication?

The man that exalts his one woman above all else is considered romantic. Yet, that is NOT God's will.

Sisters don't expect a man to bow down before you. You be a Godly woman and reverence him instead!

(See Ephesians 5:33)

Chapter 12

HIDING SPIRITS

So most first wives in the Western World as well as those in Africa and other places that have been indoctrinated into the "Monogamy Only" mindset have spirits of Idolatry and jealousy with them.

This can often be seen in as much as one can talk about abortion, or homosexuality or even pornography or incest with others around barely responding at all.

However, mention that polygamy should be allowed so that single Christian women and widows can also be loved and you will see a firestorm of emotion erupt! Heated anger and snarling lips and vehement repulsion will be seen spewing forth from the mouths of the hearers. This is especially true of first wives!

How can there be such ambivalence and apathy towards things that God calls an abomination, (murder sodomy, incest etc.) and on the other hand there is wild delirious venom poured forth about polygamy??? This is true even though polygamy is something in which many of God's most celebrated prophets participated!

The answer is, there are hidden unclean spirits present.

As long as these are appeased, in that they are ruling through women in the marriage, there is no reason to reveal their presence. They are already being idolized through the woman they inhabit.

However, when there is a threat to their rule and dominance, they raise their ugly heads to verbally beat down whoever has been so bold as to challenge their position.

Now some think that, that is good enough reason to avoid polygamy. They would say that it stirs up jealousy and witchcraft and sometimes murder.

However, we must point out, it is not polygamy that brings these spirits. It is only that polygamy is a possibility, that makes these spirits reveal themselves!

God does not want us to retain these unclean, evil spirits in our lives. Nor does he want us to keep the carnal natures, behind which they hide, with us.

God is allowing situations to show us the depth of our depravity. Envy, strife and divisions are works of the flesh. The evil spirits that hide behind this carnal nature are not to be allowed to remain with us either!

God desires that we exhibit love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness goodness meekness temperance and faith. (see Galatians 5:21,22)

When we exhibit these fruit to the degree that He desires then a man having more than one wife will not be a problem!

Chapter 13

Purified as Silver

I have been told that in order to purify certain metals they will heat it up seven times. During each melting and heating process the impurities rise to the top and then can be scraped off.

Similarly, the Bible says that we are tried like silver.

So ladies, if you want to see who is pure and who still has impurities, simply start a discussion on the need for polygamy to supply single women and widows with husbands and see what happens.

You may be doing your married female friends a favor in as much as they may not even realize the depth of the impurities within them.

After the storm has raged and the tempers have calmed perhaps you can then gently and lovingly point out the need for control over the emotions. If they are open to it, you may even be able to point out that in some cases there may need to be deliverance.

Of course some of you will respond by saying, "Why would I want to chance upsetting people and have them angry with me and perhaps start a campaign to persecute me?"

However, you should remember that the scripture says, "All that will live Godly shall suffer persecution." 2nd Timothy 3;12

And, "If we suffer with Him, we shall also reign with Him."

2nd Timothy 2:12.

So we must not fear the suffering when we are called to help our brothers and sisters in Christ!

This truth needs to get out to as many as possible so that women can be set free! Will you do your part?

Chapter 14

THE TRUTH WILL MAKE YOU FREE

Jesus said, "If you continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed: and ye shall know the truth and the truth will make you free."

There are some believers that have begun in God's word but they do not continue. They are believers but they are not disciples, for a disciple must continue!

In continuing we grow in knowledge and understanding of God's truth. As we walk in that truth, we are freed from false doctrines and the traditions of men and the binding of unclean spirits.

I had been in ministry for many years and thought that I knew God's word fairly well. When a question was put to me, it forced me to study the subject matter of many wives in more depth.

As I studied the Bible, I found that my previous position was in error. Therefore, it was necessary for me to change.

I studied the history and saw how and why the Western World has been tainted with the false doctrine of "Monogamy Only".

I presented my findings to my peers. These were men of God who had been in ministry for many years. Some agreed with my findings. Others did not like what I had found but could not refute it from scripture. Even they had to conclude that having more than one wife was not a sin.

I believe that any open minded person who will study the word in depth will come to the same conclusion.

" Study to shew thy self approved unto God, a workman that need not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

2 Timothy 2:15

Sisters, if you do this, you will know for yourselves that you can marry a married man and have a husband.

Chapter 15

THE SPIRITS OF ROME

When one submits to a spirit, he gives that spirit authority in his or

her life.

As we grow up in a culture that has submitted to certain spirits for a long, long time, we can easily submit to them and give them authority without ever realizing that we are doing so.

The Bible indicates that Roman spirits will be ruling at the end of this age, prior to the return of Christ!

One of the ways that these spirits gain entrance and rule on an individual basis is as we participate in ROMANTic activities.

A brother who was visiting the ROMAN Catholic Church was given an open vision. As one of the parishioners knelt down before one of the statues of one of the saints, he saw a huge demonic spirit stand behind the statue and towering above it accepting the homage and reverence that the person was giving!

Unclean spirits like Satan himself desire to be worshipped!

Girls in Western Society are trained to think that they should be worshipped. They are to be put on a pedestal and her potential husband is to bow down before her and ask for her hand in marriage. Unclean spirits push this agenda and sit on the shoulders, as it were, of the one receiving the kneeling reverence of the man.

The man in the mean time has been shot by cupid. More accurately, he has been possessed by a spirit of lust, that will drive him to reverence his "mother" the Venus spirit as it dwells in his intended bride. (In Roman mythology Venus, the goddess of love, was the mother of Cupid)

This is the reason that we often see husbands who treat their wives like their mothers, and submit to them as if they were little boys.

It also explains why women rise within the marriage so often and begin to dominate their husbands and treat them as children!

It is said that "love is blind.". More accurately, we should say that the spirit of "eros" blinds one.

This means that as one submits to the god of this world (Satan) or any of

his unclean spirit followers, he is blinded.

In 2nd Corinthians 4:3,4, it says, "But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost. In whom the god of this world hath BLINDED the minds of them that believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ should shine unto them.

Although some may believe enough of the good news to be saved, many are still blinded in the areas of relationships and marriage. Why? it is because although they have submitted to Jesus Christ for salvation, they have not submitted all areas of their lives to him and in those areas they are still blinded.

We must come out of paganism in order to be fully free!

It is said that, "One falls in love". People even look forward to falling in love. Many believe that the only reason to be married is if one has "fallen in love."

More accurately, we would say, "One descends into eros deception."

One rises into heaven but one descend into hell!

If we are falling we are going down. If we are going down then we are descending. The love spoken of in "falling in love" is not Agape love (God's type) it is not even Phileo Love(brotherly or family love)

It is the eros type. that is induced by the unclean spirit named eros who is otherwise known as cupid!

One should always avoid falling or descending. One should instead rise to phileo (family love) or even Agape (Godly Love).
Let's avoid the spirits of Rome!!!

Chapter 16

MARRIAGE PREPARATION

Now let's suppose that you do find a married brother in Christ who is willing to marry you as well. Marriage must still be taken very seriously. You, dear sister, are making a lifetime commitment. You should be willing to be a faithful, submissive wife to your husband.

I would recommend that you read the New Testament passages on marriage together so that you both understand the ramifications of being married. He should know his role as a husband and you should know your role as wife. By reading 1st Corinthians 11:1-10 and 1st Corinthians 7:1-5 and Ephesians 5:22-33 and 1st Peter 3:1-10, Both of you should have a clear understanding of what the Bible requires.

In short, he is the head. You each are to provide the other with due

benevolence (sexual relations) whenever either desires it.

He is to Agape love you as Christ loved the church and gave himself for it.

You are to submit to him in everything as unto the Lord!

He is to provide for you.

You are to have a meek and quiet spirit.

If you do not feel that you can fulfill your role you should not marry him!

If he can not fulfill his role, he should not marry you!

THE EXCEPTION

There is one possible exception that is based on Isaiah 4:1. It says "In that day seven women shall lay hands on one man saying we will eat our own bread and wear our own apparel, only let us be called by thy name that we may take away our reproach."

According to this passage there comes a time when women are willing to agree to marriage while providing for themselves. IF this is agreed upon before the marriage, and the woman is in no way being coerced into it, then it is possible to marry him without his being able to provide.

All of these things and probably many other ramifications should be discussed beforehand.

Experience has shown that the more things that are discussed before the marriage, the less misunderstanding and disappointment there is after the marriage.

Again, I advise you to take plenty of time to talk and prepare before the marriage.

In today's world we must address the issue of sexually transmitted diseases. In many countries the HIV/AIDS virus is raging through much of the population. In addition there are other diseases such as syphilis and gonorrhea, herpes and others as well. There must be much caution.

A wise man will make sure that any new wife that he marries does not have any STD that could be transferred to him and then through him to any other wife. Therefore, a sister in the Lord, should not be offended when her intended husband requires a medical exam or blood test to check for any Sexually Transmitted Disease before agreeing to the marriage.

Chapter 17

THE WEDDING CEREMONY

So now that you sisters understand that you can marry a married man, what should the wedding ceremony be like?

If you live in a nation that has laws against a man being married to more than one wife, you certainly can't go to the court house or the church and have an open wedding. It would not be allowed or sanctioned.

Well, exactly what is necessary?

The bride price has a scriptural precedent although there is no law or commandment that says that it must be done. That then would be based on the culture in which you find yourself.

There are no descriptions of any wedding ceremonies in the entire Bible!

We only know for sure that there were wedding feasts. Jesus attended one as we see in John chapter two. However, it does not say what the groom said or did or what the bride said or did.

Therefore, we can only conclude that there is a verbal commitment for the man to be a husband to the woman and a verbal commitment for the woman to be a wife to the man.

This ideally will be witnessed by two or more witnesses. The scripture says, "In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established."

Some might argue that this is not necessary since that verse from 2nd Corinthians 13:1 was not speaking of marriage. Still I believe that it would be a good idea, just in case the woman or the man decides to go back on what they have said before God and not be the husband or wife that they have pledged to be.

Witnesses can confirm that the vow was made.

The ceremony can take place in a home or outdoors or in a rented hall. It really doesn't matter.

The groom and the bride may wear whatever they like. We see that the bride of Christ wears a white linen garment in revelations chapter 19. That linen represents the righteousness of the saints. Because of that passage it has become traditional for many brides to wear white but this is something that is not Scripturally required.

The man states before God that he will be a husband to her, the woman states before God that she will be a wife to him. They go behind closed doors at some point and the marriage is consummated through sexual intercourse.

He is now her husband. She is now his wife.

Other things can be added. This is just the basic requirements. They can sing songs or have music played or recite poems or any thing else that they want to add to make it a memorable event. However, one should realize that all the extra things are just that and are not required by God or the scriptures.
